MASA INFORMATION

Applying for MASA

MASA is now open for registration and to apply for grants for the academic year 2019-2020.

If you are applying for a grant from MASA skip to the next paragraph. If you are not applying for a grant, all students should at least register with MASA, as it brings with it visa privileges and allows participation in all MASA sponsored activities, some of which are required by Midreshet Tehillah. Registering with MASA does not require you to disclose any financial information. When registering do not forget to select Midreshet Tehillah as your program from the drop down menu provided.

If you wish to apply for a grant or financial assistance from MASA this application counts as your registration. You should submit your application as soon as possible as they allot on a first come first serve basis and MASA cannot guarantee that they will have sufficient funds to service all applicants. You can apply for an automatic grant of \$200 – this does not require you to disclose any financial information. You can also apply for a financial need grant; this will require the disclosure of financial information. When applying do not forget to select Midreshet Tehillah as your program from the drop down menu provided.

Vacation Days

Please note that any student who is registered with MASA is not permitted to go abroad during the first and last month of seminary. If an emergency arises and you need to leave, notify Masa immediately and request its authorization.

It is also important to be aware that students on a MASA scholarship may not miss more than 30 school days during the academic year. This total includes vacation days set in the program schedule and the days of Chol HaMoed. Therefore, the total number of vacation days left available for students (besides for pre-set school vacations) will be roughly 8 days. Students who exceed this amount may have their MASA scholarship reduced. Please bear this in mind when planning family visits and/or flights home for weddings/bar mitzvahs etc.
